Roll Call: All Trustees and the Fiscal Officer were present.

Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag

The Board led the audience in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Discussion – outside legal counsel for zoning matters

Mr. Radtke led the discussion on retaining outside legal counsel for zoning matters. Several attorneys had been contacted.

2022-240-A. Mr. Radtke moved to engage Lorrie Sass-Benza at an hourly rate of \$250.00 and Alan Weinstein at \$250.00/hour on an as needed basis to provide guidance and counsel to the Chester Township Board of Trustees and Zoning Commission. Mr. Richter seconded. Vote unanimous; motion passed.

Discussion – 2023 temporary appropriations work session with Department Heads

The Department Heads and elected officials went over each department’s budget in detail, discussing and adjusting items where necessary. Discussion was had regarding scheduling of the 2023 budget public hearing with a date expected to be set at the June 20, 2022 special meeting. The General Fund budget will also be reviewed on June 20th.

Trustee Richter left the meeting at 8:22 AM.

A resident asked why the Chester News was not used for legal notices; it is due to the paper not being of “general circulation” (smaller distribution).
