Our story began in 1973 when the Walter C. White family gifted 5 acres of land for the purpose of creating a historical park to preserve & honor the history of Chester Township. An additional 5 acres was gifted by the Michael Albino Family in 20??

With a lot of dedication & generous donations we have relocated to our parcel on the corner of Mayfield & Caves Rd., the 1842 Silas Tanner house, the 1850 Town Hall, the 1899 Thayer General Store, the Original Interurban Depot, a 1900 Chester Township Barn, & even two Outhouses. The Eastern Interurban Historical Museum also has their home in the downstairs of the Old Town Hall. We have obtained & preserved many fine pieces of furniture, photos, documents, & stories of Chester's ancestors, and would like to continue to do so.

We offer free of charge to all; tours (of 5 or more), events, educational programs, & classes. All activities are supported through monetary donations as well as time & materials by volunteers, members, visitors to the village. While our events have loyal volunteers to act as docents, gardeners, carpenters, & lawn care etc., costs have risen in areas such as repairing, advertising, ground maintenance, and printing of literature.

The Chesterland Historical Board feels we are a vital non-profit organization to Chester Township & provide a positive representation while preserving our community's history.
